Did you know?

- During the 2017-18 academic year, 264 students from 63 schools attended a PLEN seminar.
- PLEN awarded over \$38,123.00 in scholarships to students in during the 2017-18 academic year.
- 54.9% of our participants are from populations historically under-represented in national public leadership because of race or ethnicity.
- 43% of participants are first generation college students who use this experience to launch a new career.

- After attending a PLEN seminar, 86% of participants say they feel better prepared for a career in public policy.
